Dubai: His Highness Shaikh Mohammad Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice- President and Prime Minister of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai, on Sunday issued law No 15 of 2010 amending law No 13 for 2006 concerning the establishment of the Centre for Ambulance Services (CAS) in the emirate of Dubai.

The amendments included a change in the name of the centre to become Dubai Foundation for Ambulance Services and assigned new functions to the institution giving it the jurisdiction to grant NOC for licensing ambulances and First Aid training centres.

The amended law also stipulated standards for professional development of workers engaged in ambulance services and set control and supervision of licensing authorities.
