

New 15 Al Qaida suspects to stand trial in Yemen

Sana'a: A total of 15 Al Qaida suspects will be put on trial in the middle of this month, the Yemen ruling party website almotamar.net quoted a prosecution official as saying late on Tuesday.

The official said they were arrested in the period between 2009 to 2010 in the provinces of Maeb, Al Jawf, Saada and Sana'a.
