

# Police arrest three for selling 4kg of heroin

Suspects hid the drugs at home and were looking for a buyer

Sharjah: Sharjah Police on Monday arrested three Pakistani men for possessing four kilograms of heroin and allegedly trying to sell it.

An official at the Anti-Narcotics Department at Sharjah Police said: "We initially received a tip-off from the General Department of Anti-Narcotics Department at the Ministry of Interior about three men smuggling a large quantity of heroin into the country."

The official told *Gulf News* police were aware the suspects had hidden the drugs at home, and were looking for a buyer. A police team raided the house and seized the heroin hidden in the bathroom.

The case has been transferred to Sharjah Public Prosecution, officials said.

## **Man stranded on mountain rescued**

A man stranded at the top of a mountain in Kalba in the Eastern Region was rescued by Sharjah Police on Sunday. A police official said the Operations Room was notified at approximately 6.15pm on Sunday about a UAE national who was stuck at the mountain's summit, located next to a tunnel leading to Wadi Al Helou, due to stormy weather. A rescue team managed to bring the man down after 45 minutes. The UAE national was then sent to a nearby hospital where he was treated for exhaustion.
